Your organization's designation as a conformity assessment body has been re-instated by the Chinese Taipei's Bureau of Standards, Metrology, and Inspection (BSMI) to test equipment under Appendix B, Phase I of the APEC MRA. This designation covers equipment testing subject to the conditions specified in Standard CNS 13438. The names of all approved laboratories will be posted on the NIST website at <a href="http://ts.nist.gov/mra">http://ts.nist.gov/mra</a> under the "APEC."

BSMI will accept test data produced by your organization to verify that the equipment to be imported into Chinese Taipei satisfies their applicable requirements. Please note that your new Lab Code assigned by BSMI is <a href="SL2-IN-E-1002R">SL2-IN-E-1002R</a>. You must apply this number to all test reports sent to BSMI. Your CAB designation will remain in force as long as your accreditation remains valid for the CNS 13438 standard.

BSMI requested the name of an authorized signatory who is authorized to sign the test reports. According to our records, Mr. John Chan is the authorized signatory for your organization.
